# **Beaver Cemetery**

Beaver, Oregon (Updated September 6, 2024)

This cemetery is located on the north side of Blaine Road after the last house on the left in Beaver, Oregon, and before R.O. Richards Road which is immediately on the left before the 1st bridge on Blaine Road heading east east of Beaver.

The cemetery began in 1884. It was first called Foland Cemetery as the property was owned by Merriman George and Mary Ann HINER Foland. Merriman died in 1893. Mary Ann donated the 1 acre cemetery on January 5, 1903, to the First United Brethren Church of Beaver.

The deed was recorded in the Tillamook County Deed Book 1, page 95. The property is Section 29, Township 3S, Range 9W.

The First United Brethren Church later became the Beaver Evangelical United Brethren Church and on September 4, 1968, it became Beaver Community Church.

In about 2020 the church ceased ownership and care of the cemetery.

In the late 1990s the Nestucca Valley Middle School began a Heritage Project that all staff and students participated in. It was a wonderful project focused on understanding and documenting South Tillamook County history. Work on the project incorporated most of the subjects taught in the school so that many of the skills taught in various subjects could be taught doing Heritage Project work. The idea was that we would not only document and learn about local history but that we would guide students in making some improvements to areas such as cemeteries.

As a local guy who loved to learn local history I, Dean Bones, a teacher at the middle school, was hooked on the project. I grew up in the Beaver area on a farm that bordered the cemetery on the west. In my earliest years in the 1950s I discovered that there was a cemetery that was overgrown with mostly alder trees and lots of brush. I

discovered that my exploration of the land just bordering my parents' farm had headstones in the brush and trees. I didn't stay in that area long after first discovering the headstones. I was definitely a bit freaked out at the time.

In later years I often wondered who many of the people where who were buried there as many of their last names were names no longer used by people living in the area. Also know that many people who attended Beaver Community Church worked on cleaning up and taking care of the cemetery in the 60s - 90s.

In 2000 I obtained a copy of the Beaver Cemetery records and retyped the the records so as to have a working document of record that could added to and revised as more information was collected. The records included names of people buried and their birth and death dates. However, many of the names were incomplete, and often the dates only included the year of birth and the year of death. Also a number of burials had occurred since the church cemetery record had been typed. In addition, I was very curious about the people buried there. Were they related to others in the local area? Had they all lived locally. What other information could I learn about their lives?

After many years of discovering and adding information to the cemetery list through discovery of local records, of searching through Ancestry records, of perusing obituaries from the past, etc. I have come to better understand who the people are who are buried in this cemetery.

Note that 1. The listing of row numbers and lot numbers is very iffy in some places as some lots are very small while others are huge and some rows seem to have merged. 2. There are over 40 unmarked graves, so space that seems to be empty on the south side of the road entering the cemetery probably has many unmarked graves. 3. There is still information to be gathered, 4. I have likely made mistakes in gathering information and in typing the information. If you plan to visit the cemetery please know that the road up to the cemetery is steep and very narrow. Also, there is a home midway up the road to the cemetery, and there are several homes further up the road after the cemetery. Be very cautious driving up the road AND driving down the road. It's quite possible you might meet another vehicle.

At various times he was the president and one of the directors of the East Beaver cheese Company, he served as a Road Supervisor and a school board member. Note that it was George & Fanny Wallace who donated the land for the Hemlock Church (Countryside Church) and donated the land for the Hemlock School.
