On April 10, 1897 A.D. Being on Saturday before the second Sunday in April, The First Nestucca Bay Eaptist Church of Christ was organized by a presbytery consisting of Eld. Wm. Bailey, Deacons David Bailey, W.C. Fewther and J.A.Dawson with twenty constituent members unanimously elected Viz:

Chas. Hogan, Elizabeth Hogan, kitty Hogan, W.L Hodson, H.J. Dawson, D.E.Dawson, G.S.Nelson, Elizabeth Nelson, Lee U.Nelson, Wm.Glick, J.H.kedwine; All lettered from the nebo Baptist Ch.

W.C. Pewther, Lydia Pewther, J.W.M. Bailey, L.M. Bailey, lettered from 1st. Baptist at Ballston, Ore.

J.J. Hudson lettered from Clay Creek Church Tenn. J.A.Dawson, N.M.F.Dawson and E.J.Redwine by relation.

Presentation of the Holy Bible and prayer by Eld. Wm. Bailey after which the Church elected J.A.Dawson and W.C.Pewther as deacons, and W.L. Hudson clerk, and organized a Sunday School. Electing officers as follows: J.J. Hudson Supt. J.A. Dawson Assist. Supt. J.H.Dawson Sect. Viola Hogan librarian, kitty Hogan traes. J.J. Hudson teacher of the bible Class, Wm. Glick junior bible Class, Lily Bailey int. Class, Elizabeth Hogan infant Class.

July, 1897 Eld. John Oliver elected Pastor. Feb. 19, 1898 Mrs. J.J. Hudson and Robert Waymire joined the church. Aug. 1898 Eld. R.Y. Blalock elected Hastor.

May 13, 1899 Sister Rosalia Buoy, Georgia Glick, Mary Kennedy, M.A. Landingham, Mable Hushbeck, Mollie Hushbeck, Liza Bailey, and Bro. Everett D. Landingham, Lester Landingham and David Bailey by relation. Eld. R.Y. Blalock by letter.

May 13,1899 After sermon by Eld. R.Y. Blalock the Lords Supper was served.

July 8,1899 The name of the Church was changed to Cloverdale Baptist Church.

July 19,1899 Sister Ina Landingham from Mt. Hebo Church was received into the Church.

Oct. 1, 1899 Sister May Blalock and Bro. James Burke were baptized. May 1900 The Church by vote decided to build on lots south of school house on Bro. Nelsons place.

In this year of 1970; Some may be interested to know of the following, Listed as members of the Cloverdale Baptist Church are, Rosalia Buoy, the mother of M.A. Landingham, born to her are Everett, Lester, Alma, and Ina Landingham.

Ina Landingham became the wife of James burke, born to them were Orrin E. Burke, Ross E. Burke, and Etta M. Burke. Born July 4,1901; I well remember my grand parents and members of the old Church.
