

John Borba

John Borba born Apr. 16, 1864 at St. George Azore Islands came to Humboldt county Calif. about 1884 and worked on a dairy farm.

Rosa Suares born July 18, 1869 at St. George Azore Islands came to Humboldt county Calif. about 1885 to join a brother and did housework and married John Borba in 1887. Their sons were born at Ferndale, Calif. and they lived on a farm until they came to Tillamook.

The John Borba family; Wife and two sons John Jr.; and Emanuel.

We left Eureka, Calif. on or about the 10th of Nov. 1892. From Eureka we went to San Francisco by steamer. Then from San Francisco to Salem, Oregon by train. After we arrived in Salem we learned that the roads over the mountains were impassable. Then we went to Portland, as there was no boat leaving Portland for Tillamook we then went to Astoria on a side-wheeler and from Astoria we took the steamer Augusta for Tillamook arriving Nov. 20th, 1892.

We lived in Tillamook that winter and the next summer. On Oct. 1st, 1893 we moved on the Peter Brandt place about 5 miles east from Tillamook City and on the north side of Wilson river and we lived on that place 4 years. On Oct. 1st, 1897 we moved back to Tillamook and lived there that winter. On April 1st, 1898 we moved on the James Hughey place about 4 miles east of Beaver on the Big Nestucca river and we lived on that place 6 years. On April 1st, 1904 we moved on the Geo. Lucas place on Bays creek. Then on Oct. 1st, 1905 we then moved on the homestead. On April 1st, 1907 we moved back on the James Hughey place and lived 6 years more. On April 1st, 1913 we moved on the Truck place on Wolfe creek, lived there a few months. Then we moved upon the Bays old place

and late that fall back on the homestead again. In 1914 we bought the Bundy place on Bays creek and moved on that place in the spring of 1915.

John Borba Jr married Viola Wilson daughter of Tom and Julia Wilson of Meda, Ore. They had two sons Quentin and Lauren.

Emanuel Borba married Ethel Jensen daughter of Hans and Adella Jensen of Beaver. They had two daughters Lucile and Hazel all born in Tillamook Co.
