My mother Fern Hackett Munro Isanhart (B) 1921- (D) 2005 divorced LeRoy in 1948 and married Byron "Nip" C. Isanhart on Dec. 17, 1949. Byron adopted myself, brother Michael Roy, and sister Mona and we all lived in Tillamook Oregon. Byron died in 2005 at the age of 91.

I'm sure you noticed the spelling of the last name. Bertha used the spelling Monroe but my birth certificate and my mother's copy of their marriage certificate shows Munro.

Perhaps LeRoy (Roy) or siblings attended Beaver School and this life story will enhance your research.
