

Blaine Cemetery

Blaine, Oregon (*Updated October 7, 2024*)

Blaine Cemetery is located on the north side of Blaine Road about 6.4 miles east of Beaver. The road to the cemetery is on the left at Blaine Community Church and continues straight up the hill past the church.

The land for the cemetery was deeded from Valentine Sears to the St. John Cemetery Association on February 19th, 1898. The deed was filed for record on March 8, 1898, and recorded in Book R, page 387 in the records of Tillamook County, Oregon.

Valentine Sears' wife, Sarah Ann BOSTON, was the first burial in 1884, 4 years before Valentine deeded the land to the St. John Cemetery Association.

The care of individual graves at the cemetery has been usually done by relatives of the person buried in the cemetery. But the overall care of the cemetery and the cemetery records were for many years done by Earl Ray Woods. Years ago that overall care was taken over by Ray's grandson, Melvin Schroeder. And in recent years Heidi TRAMBLEY Daggett has provided the physical care of cemetery including mowing it.

In the late 1990s the Nestucca Valley Middle School began a Heritage Project that all staff and students participated in. It was a wonderful project focused on understanding and documenting South Tillamook County history. Work on the project incorporated most of the subjects taught in the school so that many of the skills taught in various subjects could be taught doing Heritage Project work. The idea was that we would not only document and learn about local history but that we would guide students in making some improvements to areas such as cemeteries.

As a local guy who loved to learn local history I , Dean Bones, a teacher at the middle school, was hooked on the project of researching local history, involving students in learning about the history of our area and participating in

various projects of caring for the local area. For a number of years in the late 1990s and early 2000s all 6th graders at Nestucca Valley Middle School participated in a tour showing them where all of the known schools were and where the cemeteries in South Tillamook County were located, and it's important to note that many of those students had relatives buried in a number of the cemeteries.

As a result, many of the teachers at the middle school initiated or participated in projects to help students know the cemeteries better and do various projects to contribute to caring for cemeteries. Those included making cement headstones for some of the graves in a few cemeteries that did not have headstones, putting together benches that were placed in most of the cemeteries so that visitors would have a place to sit if they needed to, researching the people buried in the cemeteries, carefully cleaning up and restoring a few cemeteries, etc.

In South Tillamook County residents throughout the area have interacted with each other for years no matter in what community or area people lived. From the late 1800s to the current times there were over 45 schools that were in existence at one time or another. And even though several of the small school districts did operate high schools for a short time eventually all high school students in South Tillamook County attended the same high school, Nestucca Union High School which later became Nestucca High School. That high school connection has served for years to weave together the people of South Tillamook County. All of this is to say that many of us in South Tillamook County have an interest in the people buried in each cemetery in the area.

In 2000 the only Blaine Cemetery record available to the public was one at the Pioneer Museum. In April of 2004 Doris Sorensen, Patty Sorensen and Gwen Jones walked through all of the Blaine Cemetery taking notes of names of people buried there, dates of birth and of death and also included information they knew about people buried there. Their efforts helped tremendously with updating a list of the burials in Blaine Cemetery. Recently I researched people buried in Blaine Cemetery using Ancestry, Find a Grave, the internet and obituaries as resources.

At this time I have not completed the Row and Lot numbers, and I need to carefully walk through the cemetery to note any recent burials or other burials that were missed. I will post updates as needed. I have likely made mistakes in gathering information and in typing the information. Mom said she never paid the doctor bill and told him if he tried to collect she would sue him. She also said for months she would test my breathing. Quite an entrance to the world wouldn't you say."
